SUBJECT: October 26, 2021 – Consent Item First Amendment to the 2021-2022 One-Year Action Plan Budget

The Housing and Community Development Division is seeking approval of an Amendment to the 2021-2022 One-Year Action Plan Budget to award reprogrammed funds to the Pine Hills Community Cultural Center project. Orange County previously awarded funds for Phase I of the project to aid in the conversion of a former commercial shopping center into a multicultural and senior community center. Phase I has since been completed, and an application for Phase II of the Pine Hills Community Cultural Center project has been submitted during the Request for Applications process for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, which was held in spring of 2021. The County has been able to identify additional CDBG dollars from prior years to dedicate to the project.

The 2021-2022 Action Plan was approved by the Board on August 10, 2021, and it covers the period starting October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022. The Action Plan utilizes some of the CDBG funds to support capital improvements related to construction and/or rehabilitation of public facilities that provide services to low- to moderate-income individuals and families. The approved 2021-2022 One-Year Action Plan Budget must now be amended to include reprogrammed funds in the amount of \$924,000 to be awarded for continuation of construction activities on the Pine Hills Community Cultural Center.

Approval of First Amendment to the 2021-2022 One-Year Action Plan Budget to include reprogrammed Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of \$924,000 for the Pine Hills Community Cultural Center, Phase II. All Districts.
