October 26, 2021 - Consent Item **HOME ARP Grant Agreement** 

On March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan (ARP) was signed into law to provide relief funding to address the continued impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. To address the need for housing and supportive services for homeless and those with the greatest risk of housing instability, a portion of ARP funds was appropriated through the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program. Orange County, as a recipient of HOME funds, is receiving an allocation of \$10,554,916 in HOME-ARP dollars to be expended on eligible activities that must primarily serve specified qualifying populations.

Qualifying populations for HOME-ARP are those defined as: homeless; at-risk of homelessness; fleeing/attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking; and other populations where assistance would either prevent the individual or family's homelessness, or serve those with the greatest risk of housing instability, such as extremely low-income households that are severely rent-burdened. Families that include a veteran family member who meets one of these qualifying population criteria are also eligible to receive HOME-ARP assistance. Eligible activities under HOME-ARP must serve qualifying populations and include development and support of affordable housing, tenant-based rental assistance, provision of supportive services, and acquisition and development of non-congregate shelter units.

On September 13, 2021, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) published Notice CPD-21-10 to outline requirements for the use of HOME-ARP funds and a process for allocating funds to eligible activities. The process includes the following steps:

- Execution of a HOME ARP Grant Agreement Upon execution, Orange County will have access to five percent of its HOME-ARP allocation to be utilized for eligible program administration and planning activities outlined in the subsequent steps.
- Development of HOME-ARP Allocation Plan The HOME-ARP Allocation Plan that
  is based on the needs assessment and gap analysis. The Allocation Plan must identify
  activities (strategies) Orange County intends to pursue with HOME-ARP funds,
  estimated production goals, any population preferences for qualified population
  groups, and refinancing guidelines. The Allocation Plan must also include public
  participation and consultation with agencies and service providers whose clientele
  include qualified populations to identify unmet needs and gaps in housing or services
  delivery systems.
- Amendment to the 2021-2022 One-Year Action Plan Once approved by the Board, the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan and required certifications must be submitted to HUD as an amendment to the 2021-2022 One-Year Action Plan. Upon submittal to and acceptance of the Allocation Plan to HUD, the remaining grant amount (inclusive of an additional 10% administrative and planning set-aside funds) will be available to Orange County.

The HOME ARP Grant Agreement is a required first step in the process of receiving HOME-ARP funds allocated to Orange County. The budget period for the HOME-ARP funds ends on September 30, 2030.

- 21. Additional Requirements: These additional requirements are attached and incorporated into this Agreement. The Grantee agrees to these additional requirements on the use of the funds in 7., as may be amended from time to time by the Secretary.
  - a) As of the Federal Award Date, the Grantee may use up to the amount identified in 7.a. of this Agreement for eligible administrative and planning costs in accordance with the HOME-ARP Implementation Notice.
  - b) Until the date of HUD's acceptance of the Grantee's HOME-ARP allocation plan, the Grantee agrees that it will not obligate or expend any funds for non-administrative and planning costs, in accordance with the HOME-ARP Implementation Notice.
  - c) In accordance with the HOME-ARP Implementation Notice, as of the date of acceptance by HUD of the Grantee's HOME-ARP allocation plan, HUD shall make the amount identified in line 7. of this Agreement available to the Grantee.
  - d) If the Grantee does not submit a HOME-ARP allocation plan or if the Grantee's HOME-ARP allocation plan is not accepted within a reasonable period of time, as determined by HUD, the Grantee agrees that all costs incurred and HOME-ARP funds expended by the Grantee will be ineligible costs and will be repaid with non-Federal funds.
