Approval and execution of (1) Interlocal Agreement between the City of Winter Garden, Florida and Orange County, Florida regarding the Transfer of Jurisdiction of portions of certain roads; (2) County Deed for portions of 15 road segments; and (3) Assignment of eight drainage easements. PURPOSE:

The City of Winter Garden (City) has requested the County to transfer the Deed and Assign the

Easements for the portions of 15 road segments from the County to the City.

In accordance with Florida Statutes, a County Deed and an Assignment of Easements has been prepared which transfers all interest, authority, and responsibility over that portion of these 15 roads and assigns eight drainage/retention pond easements to the City. Approval of this Agreement transfers responsibility for maintaining that portion of these 15 roads to the City. Note that the City has approved and executed the Interlocal Agreement.

The County Attorney's Office has reviewed the Agreement, Deed, and Assignment and found the Agreement acceptable as to form.
