a. City of Apopka Notice of Annexation Ordinances, Exhibits, and Vicinity Maps as follows:

- Ordinance 2664, An Ordinance of the City of Apopka, Florida, to extend its territorial and municipal limits to annex pursuant to Florida Statute 171.044 the hereinafter described lands situated and being in Orange County, Florida, owned by the City of Apopka; and located at 1680 S Lake Pleasant Road; providing for directions to the City Clerk, severability, conflicts, and an effective date.

- Ordinance 2665, An Ordinance of the City of Apopka, Florida, to extend its territorial and municipal limits to annex pursuant to Florida Statute 171.044 the hereinafter described public rights-of-way known as Carnation Court, East Laurel Street, East Myrtle Street, West Myrtle Street, North Washington Avenue, North Central Avenue, North Lake Avenue (North and South of Myrtle Avenue), situated and being in Orange County, Florida, located generally west of North Park Avenue, South of West Summit Street and North of West Oak Street, and comprised of approximately 8.278 acres; owned by Orange County Board of County Commissioners; providing for directions to the City Clerk, severability, conflicts, and an effective date.

- Ordinance 2674, An Ordinance of the City of Apopka, Florida, to extend its territorial and municipal limits to annex pursuant to Florida Statute 171.044, Florida Statutes the hereinafter described lands situated and being in Orange County, Florida, owned by the City of Apopka; and located on the east side of N Hiawassee Road and south of US 441/Orange Blossom Trail; providing for directions to the City Clerk, severability, conflicts, and an effective date.

- Ordinance 2675, An Ordinance of the City of Apopka, Florida, to extend its territorial and municipal limits to annex pursuant to Florida Statute 171.044 the hereinafter described public rights-of-way know as North Hiawassee Road, Lust Road, East Votaw Road, North Christina Avenue, South Christina Avenue, Vick Road, West Martin Street, East Nancy Lee Lane, and West Nancy Lee Lane, situated and being in Orange County, Florida, and comprised of approximately 16.341 acres; owned by Orange County Board of County Commissioners; providing for directions to the City Clerk, severability, conflicts, and an effective date.
